IMMUNIZATION POLICY

We are required by North Carolina law to administer vaccines to all healthy infants, children, and adolescents at the recommended dosing schedule set by the NCIP. The only two exceptions to this requirement are for Religious Exemption and/or Medical Exemption. Children will not be exempt for non-religious personal beliefs or philosophies.

A Religious exemption must be accompanied by submission of a written statement of the bona fide religious beliefs and opposition to the immunization requirements.

A Medical exemption is a statement by a Licensed Physician that a required immunization is or may be detrimental to a person's health due to the presence of one of the contraindications adopted by the Commission for Public Health.
